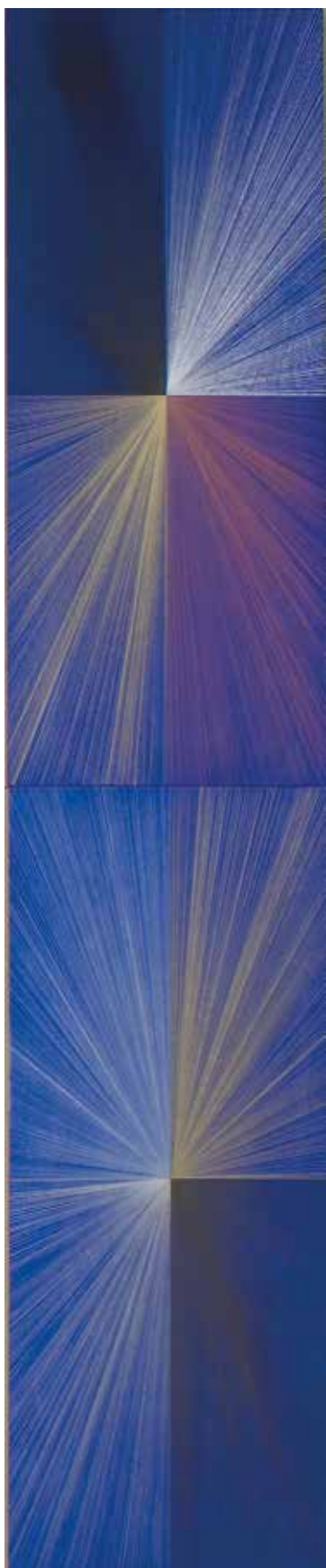

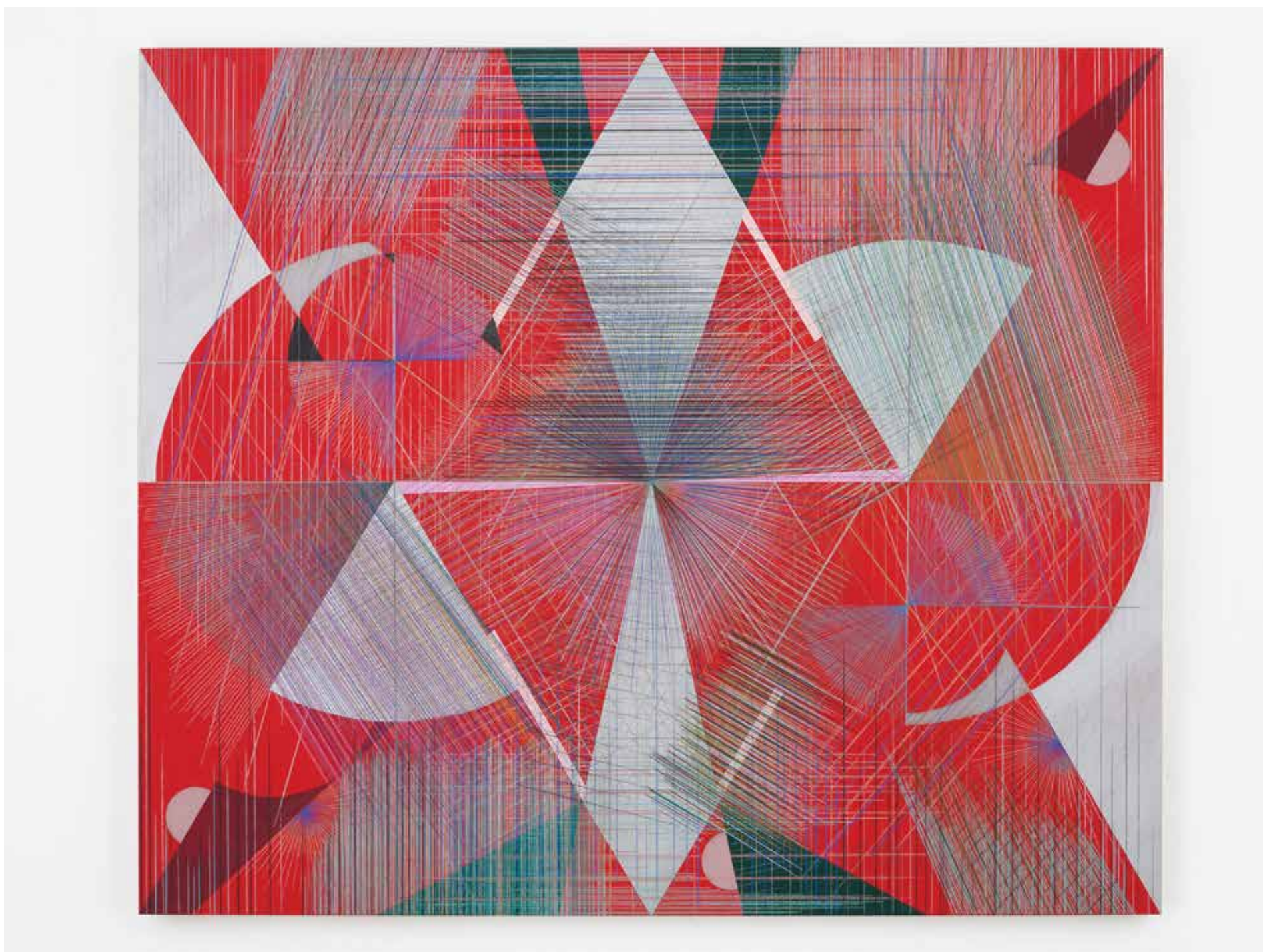
"Soho Room (Blue I)"

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German artist Lothar engages with ideas of space and abstract through his line drawings which are built up through layers of juxtaposing colours. Brought together in dense compositions on painted board these thin pencil lines explore the impact of using varying colours and intensities on the work's surface. Referencing and expanding upon the abstract language of Suprematism and the Bauhaus, the colours appear to oscillate in front of the viewer to immerse them in the surrounding space. Guided by experience and artistic decision instead of algorithms or random rules, the pattern develops intuitively which balances the sharply defined geometry of line with an exuberant and joyful show of colour.
